It is a plain area, so the scenery isn't amazing like in the mountains. But there are lots of buildings and parks in Craiova, as well as many cultural attractions.



Afterwards, we can take a stroll through the city center and have a light lunch while enjoying the musical fountains.




We have a great football team, that plays on the Ion Oblemenco stadium.
