






# ECO-SCHOOL PROGRAM GREEN SCHOOLS PROGRAM

ECO-CODE: A CLEAN ENVIRONMENT FOR OUR HEALTH!





"Environmental Education for Green Schools" is an educational kit put together as part of the "Green School Platform – advocacy, environmental education and support for sustainable schools" program, a project funded by 2009 – 2014 EEA grants through Romania's NGO Fund.

The purpose of the **Environmental Education for Green Schools** course is to provide students with a comprehensive learning experience that combines elements and features of formal, nonformal and informal education, and that complies with the basic Education for Sustainable Development – ESD principles: vision, student-centered, critical thinking, systems thinking, partnership, involvement, in touch with the real lives of children and communities, solution-oriented and action-oriented. This kind of education can bring about changes in environmental education for teachers and schools.

The suggested teaching methodology and thematic content have been designed by the authors with the intent to help strengthen the following values and attitudes in the students participating in the programme:

- Respect for nature as the space that accomodates our daily living;
- Interest in exploring nature locally;
- Appreciation for the services that nature provides people;
- Responsability in terms of an informed behaviour as to consuming the services provided by nature;
- Interest in science and new technologies as part of sustainable development;

- Responsibility in managing our own decisions which have an environmental impact;
- Critical thinking aplied to daily consumption behaviours;
- Involvement in solving environmental issues at school/community level;
- Teamwork;
- Open-mindedness to others and other's opinions;
- Understanding the diversity of local cultures;
- Inner motivation to relate with the living environment.

The Teacher's Guide as part of the educational kit is coordinated by a specialist from **WWF-Romania**, a person in charge of education in **the Green School Platform – advocacy**, environmental education and support for sustainable schools project.

The aim of the "Green School Platform – advocacy, environmental education and support for sustainable schools" project carried out by the **Greenitiative Association** and its partners, **WWF Romania and Viitor Plus – Association for Sustainable Development** was to focus the efforts of civil society active in the area of environmental protection in order to support secondary school teachers wanting to introduce environmental education into the school curriculum, subject to the school management's decision.

This material was translated into English as part of the "Green schools –environmental education at a national level" project carried out within the "Together with Lidl for a better future" programme by WWF Romania and its partners Greenitiative Association and British Council.

-planting and taking care of trees and flowers- cleaning the classrooms and the spacesaround the school building

































-identification of and raising awareness related to the living area



























































